The 1930s were a pivotal decade for the auto industry, marked by significant innovations in design and performance. As the premier luxury automobile manufacturer of that era, Packard played a prominent role in shaping the automotive landscape with its elegant and stylish vehicles.

The introduction of the 1934 V12 Victoria was a significant milestone for the Packard Motor Company, greatly influenced by the Art Deco and aerodynamic trends of the era. Its lower, more streamlined Dietrich-bodied styling featured lengthy hoodline, skirted, full-figured fenders, a V-shaped radiator flanked by bullet headlamps with matching V-shaped lenses, and a subtly raked windscreen. With the convertible top up or down, the 1934 V12 Victoria exuded an air of unprecedented style and sophistication.

Prestige meets performance

A testament to the designers of the Packard Twelve Series lineup produced between 1933 and 1934, the 1934 V12 Victoria was also celebrated for its engineering excellence. There was plenty of power to match the prestige of those svelte and exquisitely proportioned body lines. Boasting a 445.5 cubic inch 7.3-liter V12 engine delivering a near-silent 160 horsepower capability, it ranked amongst the most desirable American luxury cars of the pre-war era.

Fewer than ten 1934 Packard Twelve Series Victorias exist today. One of these extremely rare and sought-after classics sold at the RM Sotheby’s Amelia Island Auction for \$4.13 million in 2022, a record for any auctioned Packard.
